In addition to the provisions of the SCCSC Responsible Use Policy, the following additional items apply to students participating in the Chromebook program.

1. Students will bring their Chromebooks to school each morning with the battery fully charged.
2. Students will transport their Chromebook to and from school in the school issued carrying case and will store the Chromebook in a secure location when not in use.
3. Students will keep their Chromebooks clean with no attached stickers or other items that might deface or damage the Chromebook finish, screen, or other components.
4. No attempts will be made without school permission to modify, reconfigure, or repair the Chromebook.
5. Students will immediately report all malfunctions, damage, or loss of a Chromebook to a classroom teacher or technology support staff member at their school.
6. User/Parent/Guardian will be financially accountable for any repairs due to damage, loss or theft of the device.
7. Loss or theft of the Computer must be reported to the District by the next school day after the occurrence and a police report may be required.
8. Use of school-issued mobile devices off the school network may be monitored.
9. Students will use their Chromebook during the school day only for school-related purposes.
10. Students will only use wireless network connections at school and will not connect to any cellular network or non-district wireless access point while at school.
11. Unless part of a school project and with the knowledge of a staff member, students will not use email, instant messaging or log into chat rooms or online forums during school hours.
